## Elementary Education (Grades 1-6)

The Elementary Education Major requires 54 credits in Education courses; 36 credits of required coursework, 4 credits of pre-practica experience and 12 credits of full practicum. The major requires a 2<sup>nd</sup> major; Applied Psychology and Human Development, Transformative Educational Studies, LSEHD interdisciplinary major or an MCAS major.
