

Boston College Parents' Weekend

Frequently Asked Questions

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Q: Will I be receiving additional information on Parents' Weekend?

A: You will receive our Parents' Weekend brochure in the mail by mid-July. Those who have registered will receive a packet complete with maps and parking instructions the first week of September.

Q: How do I register for Parents' Weekend? Is it necessary to register for Parents' Weekend?

A: All families attending Parents' Weekend are required to register in advance through our secure website. This will ensure that we know how many people are attending non-ticketed events and assist our office in preparing materials for everyone attending the weekend. Please be sure to include your student in your headcount.

Q: Is there a deadline for registering?

A: Yes. The deadline to register is Thursday, September 26. However, tickets do sell out for the Pops on the Heights Scholarship Gala, so we recommend that you order early. Those who have registered by September 18 will receive a registration packet complete with maps and parking instructions by mail prior to Parents' Weekend. Those who have registered after this date will receive an emailed copy of the registration packet materials. Extra registration packets can be picked up at the Welcome Center on Friday as well.

Q: Is there a cost for Parents' Weekend?

A: Yes. The Pops on the Heights Scholarship Gala, the Pregame Barbecue, and the football game are all ticketed events. When you register, there is a \$25 flat fee per family. This will help to offset the cost of increased security, shuttle buses and food services for non-ticketed events. **Save \$5 when you register before September 6!**

TICKET INFORMATION

Q: Are any tickets on sale now?

A: Yes. Tickets for the Pops on the Heights Scholarship Gala, football game and the Pregame Barbecue are on sale now. You can purchase tickets for Pops on the Heights and the Pregame Barbecue when you register for Parents' Weekend online. [Football tickets](#) can be purchased using promo code PARENTS.

Q: Who should I contact regarding my Pops, Football, Pregame Barbecue ticket question?

A: For questions regarding Pops tickets, please call 800-767-5591. For questions regarding football tickets or kickoff time, please call 617-552-4622. For questions regarding the Pregame Barbecue tickets or other Parents' Weekend questions please email parentsweekend@bc.edu or call 866-237-1120.

Q: When will I receive my tickets?

A: Registration packets, including tickets for the Pregame Barbecue will be sent out after Labor Day. Pops on the Heights tickets will be mailed out in September as well. Tickets for the football game will be mailed out depending on when you place your order. Please note that all tickets will be mailed separately.

Q: Do students typically attend the Pops concert with their families?

A: Yes, students typically attend the Pops concert with their families. If your student will be attending, please be sure to order their ticket when you purchase your tickets online so that your family will be seated together. Additional ticket orders after the date of purchase will be accepted, however they cannot be seated with original orders.

Q: When is kickoff time for the football game typically announced?

A: Kickoff will be announced on or before September 23 on the athletics website at www.bceagles.com.

Q: Can my student sit with me for the football game?

A: Your student may sit with you only if you buy a ticket for him or her with your ticket order. Most students have season tickets and opt to sit in the student section, meeting with their family before and after the game.

Q: Can we tailgate on campus prior to the football game?

A: Those with season ticket football parking permits may tailgate on campus prior to the football game. Otherwise, there will be no outside parking or tailgating permitted on game day.

PARKING, LODGING AND DINING INFORMATION

Q: Where can I find information about parking?

A: Information regarding parking on Parents' Weekend will be included in your registration packet and will be available on our website in September. For campus maps, please visit [BC's Maps and Directions](#) page.

Please note that we strongly encourage you to use the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA or the "T") subway system during your Parents' Weekend stay. The Boston College branch of the MBTA's Green Line (the B train) ends at the Boston-Newton boundary on Commonwealth Avenue. Cross the street and walk by St. Ignatius Church and follow the perimeter road around to campus entrances. If you are planning to stay in Boston, this is a convenient way of getting to campus without needing a car.

Q: When should I make hotel reservations?

A: Hotels fill up quickly. We recommend making reservations as soon as you know you are planning to come to campus for Parents' Weekend. Please visit the [Parents' Weekend](#) website for a list of area hotels. Please note that Boston College does not have a Parents' Weekend room block at any hotels.

Q: Where can I find information about places to eat on campus?

Q: Where can I find information about places to eat off campus?

OTHER INFORMATION

Q: May I bring other family members (i.e., grandparents, younger children) to Parents' Weekend?

A: Parents' Weekend is open to all, and we encourage you to bring your entire family.

Q: Can I drop off supplies to my student at his or her dorm?

A: Supplies may be dropped off on Friday and Sunday during Parents' Weekend. Please notify the gate attendant that you will be dropping off and not parking. Unfortunately, due to game day parking restrictions, you will not be able to access campus without a valid parking permit on Saturday.

Q: What is the dress code for Parents' Weekend?

A: The dress code is primarily casual. You should dress to be comfortable. Dress for the Pops on the Heights Scholarship Gala and the Sunday Liturgy tends to be a little more formal.
