The Boston Police Department has reported numerous off-campus residential burglaries that have occurred during the evening and early morning hours in the Foster Street, Greycliff and Gerald Road neighborhoods of Brighton.

The victims have reported jewelry and electronics, such as laptops stolen during the incidents.

As a reminder the Boston College Police Departments encourages you to do the following:

- Lock your doors and windows. This includes patio doors and windows on upper floors, and keep those access points secured at all times.
- Remove or secure air-conditioners that are in windows.
- Keep items such as ladders secured and away from your residence.
- Be aware of your surroundings and get to know your neighbors.
- Avoid leaving valuables in plain site from windows.
- Keep a descriptive inventory of valuables, to include serial numbers if applicable.
- Report suspicious activity and persons to police immediately.
