## **Message from the Director**

Dear Students,

As we turn to December and the last few weeks of the semester, I would like to offer a few reminders and suggestions regarding the upcoming January 5, 2025 study abroad deadline.

If you are interested in studying abroad during the 2025-26 academic year (fall, spring, or full year), all students must apply by January 5. In order to be eligible to apply, all students must complete the <u>Initial</u> <u>Advising Questionnaire</u>, attend a <u>Study Abroad 101</u>, and complete the <u>My OGE App</u>. The deadline applies to all semester programs. This includes BC programs and approved external (non-BC) programs. Any student wishing to study abroad next year must be approved by OGE. Students are not permitted to study abroad outside of this established process.

The last Study Abroad 101 is scheduled for December 13,

2024. Please plan accordingly. No further 101s will be scheduled during the winter break.

For meetings with our Program Managers/Study Abroad Advisors, please read the section below for separate instructions.

Once you have completed the 101, please be sure to apply by the January 5 deadline. Please pay particular attention to the "Conversation about Study Abroad Recommendations" in your My OGE

App. OGE only asks students to have a brief conversation with a faculty member; it is not a written recommendation.

A word on applying to study abroad: it is better to apply for approval to study abroad by the deadline. Applying to study abroad is not a binding decision; you can apply and decide to turn down the opportunity. However, OGE does not accept late applications; after January 5, there is no longer an opportunity to be considered for a study abroad program. Additionally, students are not permitted to apply to a semester study abroad program without first being approved by OGE. This means if you are considering a semester or year abroad, you must apply by January 5, 2025.

Please be mindful that Boston College strives to have a balanced study abroad enrollment between the fall and spring semesters. It is likely that some students who are only considering spring semester options may be approved for a fall semester abroad and vice versa. Please plan accordingly as you finalize your six choices. We recommend avoiding selecting programs all in one city or only in one specific term. Students are reminded to fully review any programs they select so as to be as informed as possible regarding their selections. Once the January 5th deadline has passed, there is no opportunity to make changes to your application, which includes your program/term selections.

For our departing spring semester abroad students, OGE hopes you have a wonderful experience abroad!

All students, please note BC and OGE will be closed for the winter holidays starting on December 21st. BC will reopen on December 30 and 31st, closing for the January 1 holiday, and then be fully open again starting January 2. Please plan accordingly during winter break and note that messages sent to the office may be delayed as staff usually take time off at the end of the year.

If you are considering a summer study abroad program, the deadline to apply is February 5, 2025. Boston College <u>summer faculty-led programs and internships abroad</u> are another great option for students considering spending time abroad.

I encourage you to reach out to OGE if you have any final questions or concerns. Best of luck with your upcoming final papers and exams. On behalf of the OGE, I hope you all have a wonderful holiday season!

## Meeting with Study Abroad Advisors

Individual study abroad advising sessions, 1-on-1 sessions with study abroad advisors, are filling up quickly! However, study abroad advisors offer group advising sessions for most of their programs. These group advising sessions are a good alternative to individual advising appointments and count as the mandatory advising appointment which may be required for some study abroad programs.

Please check for specific times these meetings are offered and be sure to follow the prompts to book the correct group session you are interested in attending. We also recommend checking the advising appointment pages frequently as space may open up for individual appointments. If group appointments do not work, or you have a brief question, please feel free to email the advisor directly.

If you are heading home for break and already have booked a 1-on-1 session, do not cancel! OGE can conduct these sessions virtually; just email your advisor to let them know and they activate the Google Meet link in the calendar appointment.
