**Message from the Director** 

October finds us in the midst of advising. As noted in our September newsletter, students should be attending our <u>Study</u> <u>Abroad 101s</u> throughout the fall in anticipation of the January 5,



2025 application deadline for all semester programs. As you complete the Study Abroad 101 group session and gain access to your study abroad application, we ask students to continue their abroad research via the OGE <a href="website">website</a>, and each partner university's website. This is also a good time to meet with one of our regional Study Abroad Advisors. Our Study Abroad Advisors are ready to answer all your abroad questions.

As you research program choices, the OGE recommends searching beyond the large cities and focusing on smaller, regional cities, in Europe and beyond. Students will learn in the Study Abroad 101s, that the large European cities are the most popular choices. Since OGE cannot guarantee students will get their first or second choices, we advise students to be mindful when researching and selecting programs.

More competitive programs will list the typical number of applicants and potential spots available on their <a href="Program Pages">Program Pages</a>. Please note too that competitive or popular programs do not equate with these programs being better programs. Boston College partners with well-respected universities and programs across the globe. There are multiple programs and locations that will work for multiple reasons. Students should plan well in advance, keeping in mind OGE's responsibility to equally balance enrollment across the fall and spring semesters.

In this newsletter, you will find more information regarding our newly announced 2025 **summer program offerings**. We offer a number of BC faculty-led summer programs, as well as internship programs in various locations throughout Asia, Africa, and Latin America. More information is highlighted in the newsletter.

We invite juniors preparing to study abroad next semester, as well as eligible students planning to study abroad in Summer 2025 to meet with the <u>Scholarships Advisor</u> and work on prestigious awards, with various <u>scholarships and grants</u> application deadlines coming up this month.


