

Commuter Benefit Program

Tax Savings & Convenience

Boston College offers a Commuter Benefit Program. Employees may order commuter passes on-line and enjoy the convenience of pre-tax payroll deductions. The program is administered by WageWorks (now Health Equity/WageWorks, the same company that administers our Flexible Spending Account Plans).

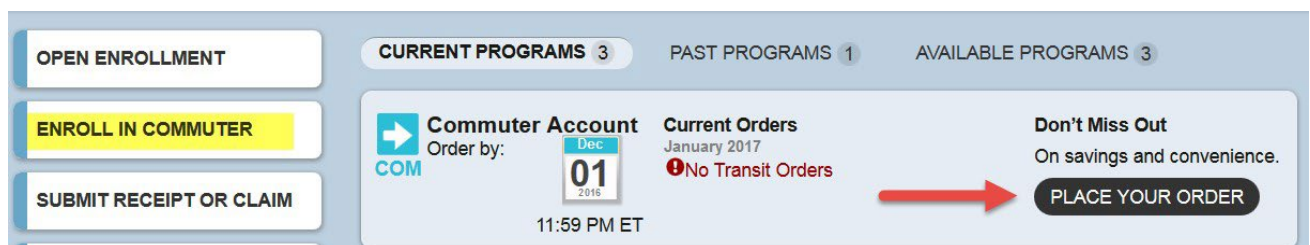
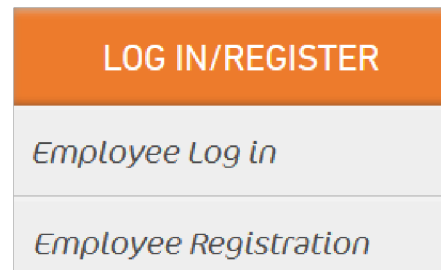
You pre-pay for the commuter pass. For example, the deduction(s) withheld from your pay in June are to pre-pay for the July commuter pass. For monthly paid employees, the pre-tax deduction will be withheld from your monthly paycheck. For weekly paid employees, the pretax deductions will be withheld from 3 weekly checks per month - in the 2nd, 3rd and 4th weeks. The tax savings could be up to 25-30% of the pass cost. Passes are mailed to your home address that is listed in Agora.

To participate in the Commuter Benefit Program and order your pass on-line, follow these steps.

1. www.wageworks.com
2. Click on the orange Log In / Register button on the upper right hand side
3. If you don't already have a WageWorks username & password, click on the "Employee Registration" link. (If you already have a WageWorks username & password, simply log in. The next screen will give you the option to order your commuter pass.)
4. Follow the prompts for "First Time User Registration." When asked for your "ID Code" enter the last four (4) digits of your Social Security number. NOTE: WageWorks does NOT have your full Social Security number.
5. Once registered and logged in, you'll have the option to "Enroll in Commuter" or "Place your Order."



If you do not have a WageWorks username & password, click on "Employee Registration" to begin. If you do have a WageWorks username & password, simply click on "Employee Log In" and enter your username & password.
