Please read before accessing the online BC Financial Aid Application:

- **First Time Users:** In order to start the application, you will have to create an account (upper right portion of website). You can use any email address; however, when creating a password, do not use any password associated with your other Boston College credentials. This account is hosted by a third-party vendor, and if you need to share this account password with your parent/guardian, it is important that you are not using your BC password(s).
- **Returning Users:** If you completed the BC Undergraduate Aid Application for 2024–2025, you should already have credentials for this application. If you cannot remember your password, use the Forget Password feature. If you do not have access to the email address used last year, or do not remember the address used, please follow the directions above as a First Time User.
- Once you have logged into the site, please make sure you select the correct form for the appropriate year. You want to complete the 2025–2026 Undergraduate Financial Aid Application.
- Numerical values in this application (income, assets, etc.) should be reported to the nearest whole dollar amount without dollar signs or decimal characters. Do not include cents as a part of the number. For example, if the amount is \$1,934.21, it should be reported in the application as 1934.
- You are able to save your progress and log back into your account at a later time. You can also share your log in information to allow access to your parent(s)/guardian(s).
- Only one certification (signature) is required for this application.
- You can only submit this application once. At the end of the application, you are able to print a copy. We suggest reviewing the information prior to hitting the submit button. It is also advised to save a copy of this application for your records.
